




Do you think that eTwinning project "Inside the rainbow" increased your child's motivation for studying? Rate from 1 to 5 if 5 is "I totaly agree"




Do you think that thanks to the project your child increased her/his interest in reading books and read more in her/his free time? Rate from 1 to 5 if 5 is "I totaly agree".




Do you think that the project has increased the communication competence in mother tongue of your child? Rate from 1 to 5 if 5 is "I completely agree".




Do you think that the project has increased the communication competence in foreign language of your child? Rate from 1 to 5 if 5 is "I totaly agree".






How often do you talk with your child about the project?






